The docks are engineered to withstand 74 mph winds and are anchored by steel piles, ensuring stability even during severe ice conditions and wave action. With premium composite decking, the docks are as visually appealing as they are resilient.

Harbormaster Matt Specht highlighted the project's efficiency and sustainability. "We leveraged the lessons learned from the B Dock project to streamline the C Dock reconstruction, completing it ahead of schedule," he said. Additionally, we were able to recycle a significant amount of material, reducing overall project costs and enhancing our commitment to environmental responsibility."
