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The Prairie Harbor Yacht Club recently announced the completion of its dock reconstruction initiative, with the new floating docks boasting state-of-the-art tech and engineering according to a press release.

PHYC completed the second phase of its modernization project this season with the unveiling of the newly upgraded C Dock, following the replacement of B Dock in 2022.



The docks feature 240V power to accommodate the latest boating trends, and are designed to endure the elements, and are durable and functional. The docks are reportedly engineered to withstand 74 mph winds and are anchored by steel piles, ensuring stability even during severe ice conditions and waves.

"Our new docks are built for whatever Mother Nature might have in store, be it summer storms or harsh winter conditions," said Greg Groenke, PHYC Board President.

Harbormaster Matt Specht highlighted the project's efficiency and sustainability.

"We leveraged the lessons learned from the B Dock project to streamline the C Dock reconstruction, completing it ahead of schedule," he said. "Additionally, we were able to recycle a significant amount of material, reducing overall project costs and enhancing our commitment to environmental responsibility."
